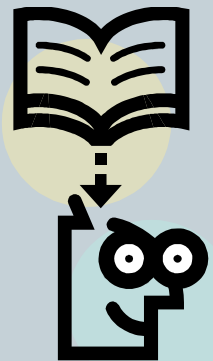

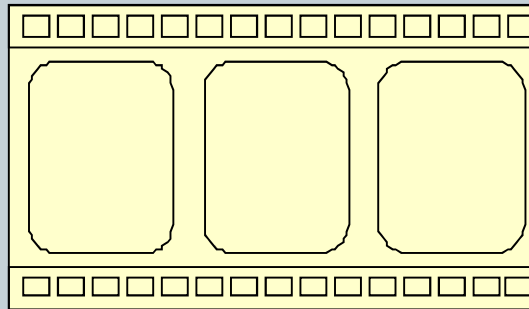

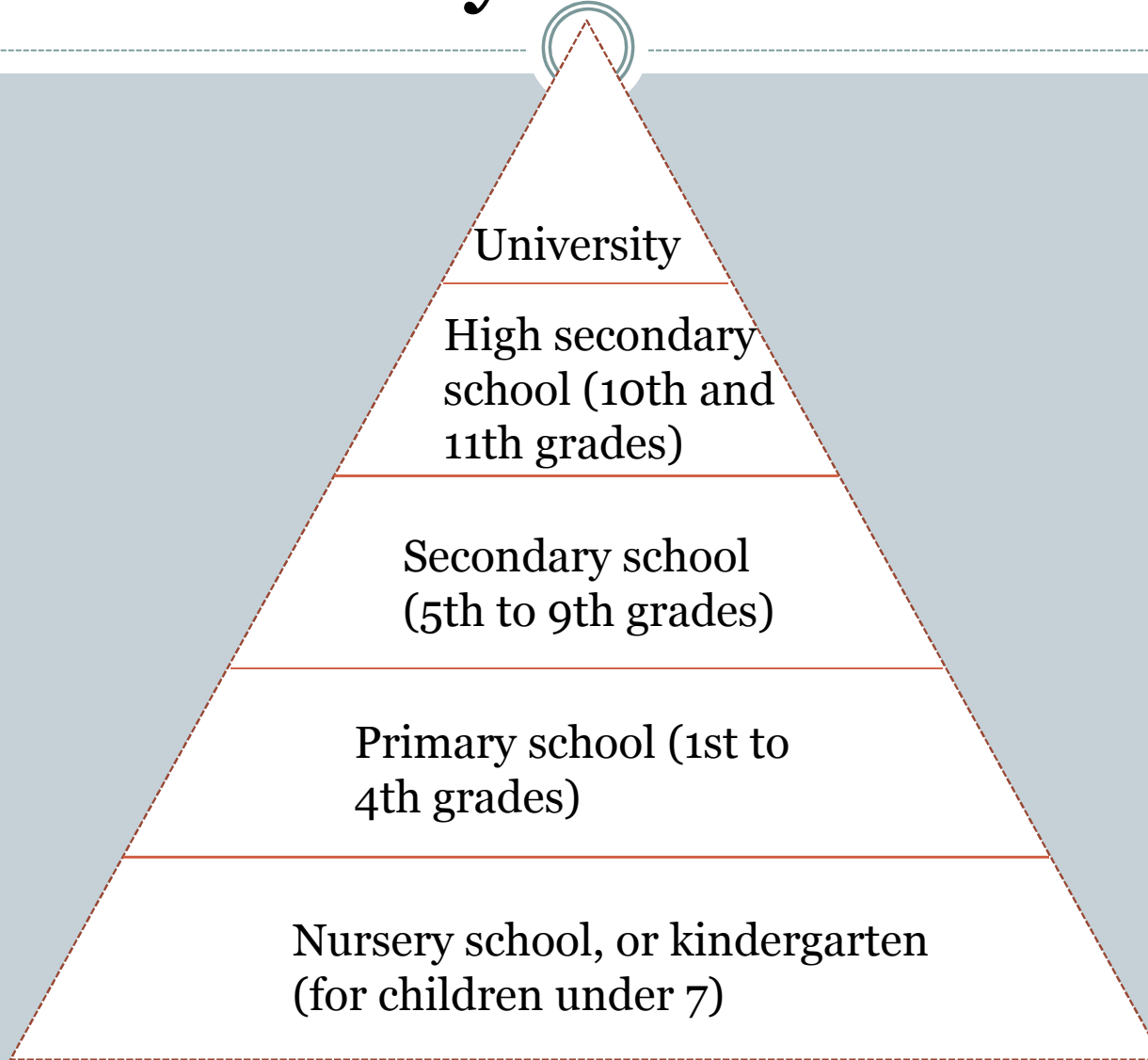
# GENERAL EDUCATION



- General education curricula normally stipulate 34 weeks of study per year and, as a rule, 27 to 38 hours of study per week.
- The school year starts on 1 September and runs through the beginning of June. Unified State Examinations scheduled in the end of May – beginning of June are culminating school studies.
